

JWA Has Released “Heatstroke Zero 2021” Brochure In 3 Languages: English, Chinese, Korean.

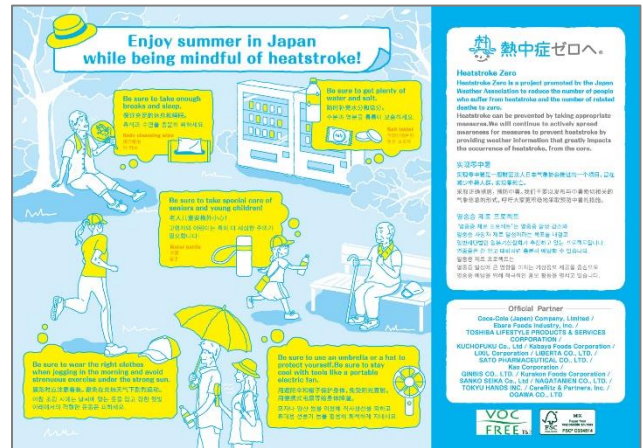
