Japan Weather Association supports SDGs.

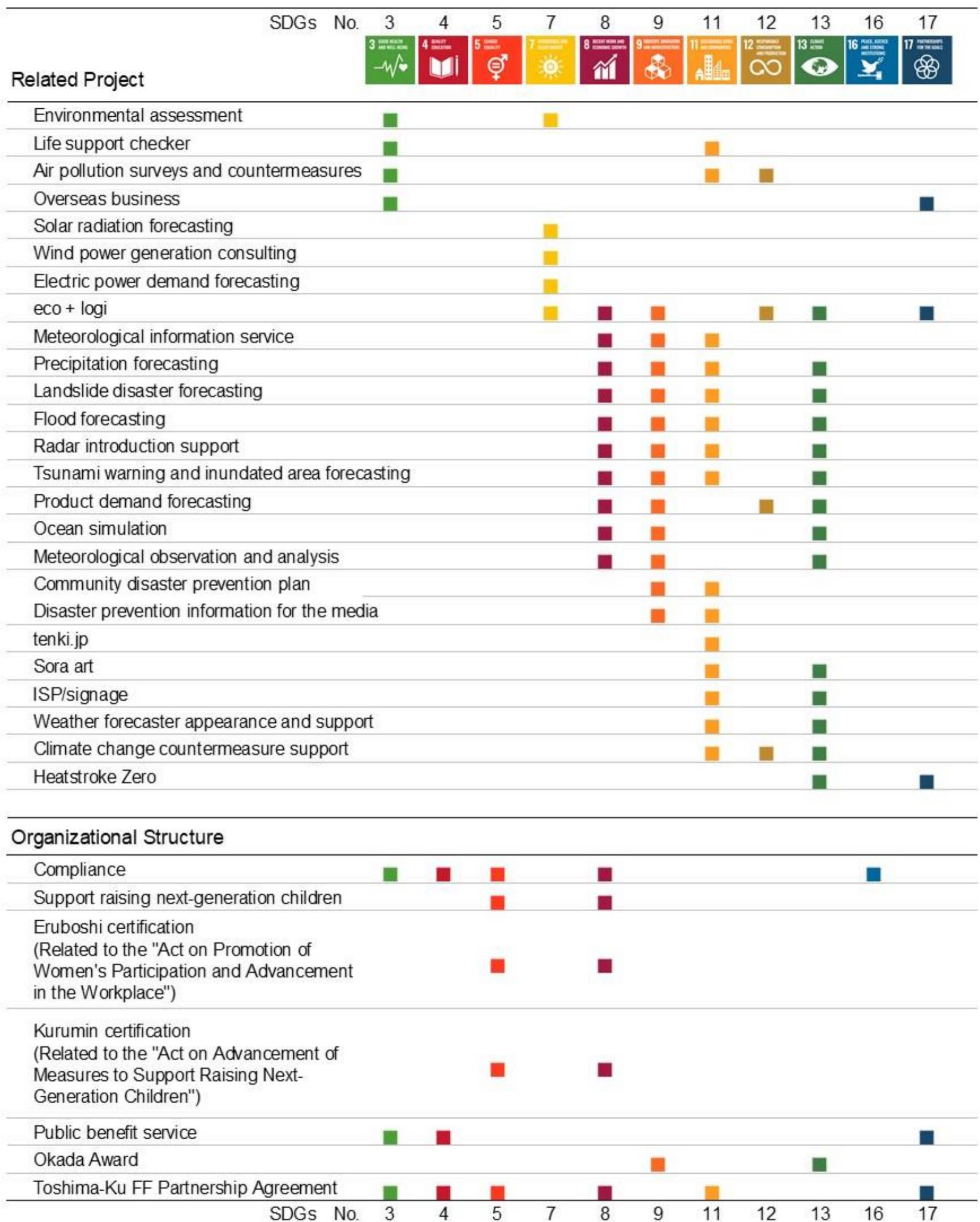
